FINAL JUDGMENT

On February 28, 2022, this case proceeded to trial before the Court and a jury. The case having been tried and the jury having rendered its verdict on March 15, 2022, it is the JUDGMENT and DECREE of the Court as follows:

1. For judgment rendered as to Defendant **Melissa McDickinson**,
 - a. Judgment is entered in favor of Defendant Melissa McDickinson as to Claim 5 (Invasion of Privacy) and Claim 7 (Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress) of the Third Amended Complaint (*see* Doc. 5) by way of jury verdict;
 - b. Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff Ka'Toria Gray and against Defendant Melissa McDickinson as to Claim Three (Assault and Battery) by way of jury verdict in the total amount of \$25,000;
 - c. Due to judgment entered against Melissa McDickinson on the claim for assault and battery and due to the voluntary dismissal with prejudice

of her counterclaim against Ka'Toria Gray on February 25, 2022 (*see* Doc. 459), Plaintiff Ka'Toria Gray's costs are taxed against Melissa McDickinson for which execution may issue.

2. For judgment rendered as to Defendant **David Birchfield**,

a. Judgment is entered in favor of Defendant David Birchfield as to Claim 4 (Invasion of Privacy) and Claim 6 (Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress) of the Third Amended Complaint (*see* Doc. 5) by way of jury verdict;

b. Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff Ka'Toria Gray and against Defendant David Birchfield as to Claim Two (Assault and Battery) by way of jury verdict in the total amount of \$25,000;

c. Due to judgment entered against David Birchfield on the claim for assault and battery on this day and due to the voluntary dismissal with prejudice of his counterclaims against Ka'Toria Gray on February 25, 2022 (*see* Doc. 459), Plaintiff Ka'Toria Gray's costs are taxed against David Birchfield for which execution may issue.

3. For judgment rendered in favor of Defendant **Koch Foods of Alabama, LLC** on all claims tried by way of jury verdict,

a. The action as to Defendant Koch Foods of Alabama, LLC is dismissed on the merits; and
