Civil Jury Verdicts

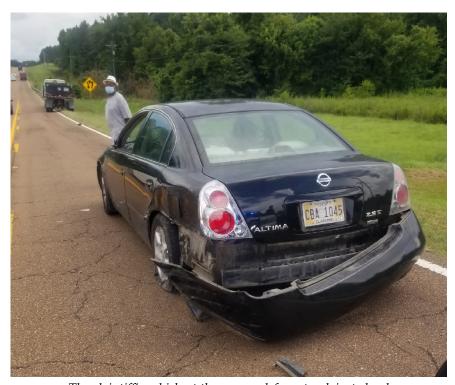

It was 7-14-20 and Marie Drew,

age 73, was stopped to turn on Hwy 61 outside of Port Gibson. Behind her in traffic was Joshua Coleman who was driving a commercial truck for Score 4 Trucking. An instant later Coleman rear-ended Drew. It was a moderate collision. Score 4 Trucking (it is no longer a going concern) conceded fault.

Drew was treated at the local ER for apparent soft-tissue symptoms including to her shoulder, neck and back. She later underwent a shoulder repair surgery. Her neck and back pain has persisted through a course of conservative care.

The treating Dr. Daniel Dare, Orthopedics, identified that Drew will require future steroid injections and physical therapy. Drew's past
