Civil Jury Verdicts

Construction Negligence - The plaintiff suffered catastrophic burn injuries when just installed water line encroached a natural gas line – the jury in this case awarded nearly \$9.8 million in medicals and lost wages plus \$2,000,000 each for his suffering and his wife’s loss of consortium – while no judgment has yet been entered, the parties are

expected to litigate how tort reform caps will be applied (if at all) to the case
