The Court, pursuant to Trial Rule 58(B) of the Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure, enters judgment as follow:

- A. This cause was submitted to trial by jury commencing on June 21, 2022 and continuing through June 22, 2022. The cause was submitted upon the Plaintiff's Complaint and the Defendant's Answer to Complaint. The Court was deemed to have jurisdiction over this cause of action.
- B. Plaintiff in person and by counsel, Calvin Miller. Defendant by counsel, Bailey Coultrap.
- C. The issue to be determined by the jury was:
 - a. The nature and extent of the injury and damages of the Plaintiff.
- D. Trial commenced on June 21, 2022. Voir Dire was conducted. Six jurors were selected. The Court gave Court's Preliminary Jury Instructions No. 1-13. Counsel gave opening statements. The Plaintiff commenced her case-in-chief. The Plaintiff rested. The trial adjourned for the evening.

Trial resumed on June 22, 2022. Defendant commenced his case-in-chief. Defendant rested. No rebuttal. The Court rejected all jury instructions tendered by the parties and proposed giving the Court's Final Jury Instructions No.'s 1 through 24. Counsel gave closing arguments. The Court read Court's Final Jury Instructions No.'s 1 through 24. The jury retired to deliberate at approximately 12:10 p.m. At approximately 1:10 p.m., the bailiff reported that the jury had reached a verdict. The jury was returned to open court. The verdict was read in open court.

VERDICT

We, the jury, find that for the Plaintiff, Amy Neher, and against the Defendant, Geoffrey Wheeler, and assess damages in the amount of \$310,500.00.


The verdict is dated 6-22-22 and signed by the foreperson, Juror #63.

The jury was discharged.

WHEREFORE, the Court enters judgment in favor of the Plaintiff, Amy Neher, and against the Defendant, Geoffrey Wheeler in the amount of \$310,500.00 and statutory post-judgment interest of 8% per annum.

Court costs assessed to the Defendants.
