JURY INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTION NO. 1

- 1.Immediately upon retiring to the jury room, you shall elect one (1) member as foreperson;
- 2.Nine (9) or more of you must agree in order to answer any of the questions or make any of the determinations required by these instructions;
- 3.If all twelve (12) of you agree on the answers to all the questions and determinations, which you are required to make, the foreperson alone may sign for you;
- 4.Each answer or response on which the verdict is not unanimous must be signed by the nine (9) or more of you who agree;
- 5.The nine (9) or more of you that agree on one (1) instruction need not be the same nine (9) or more that agree on any other instruction.

INSTRUCTION NO. 3

You will determine from the evidence and award Norman Conley a sum or sums of money that will fairly and reasonably compensate him for each element of damage listed below that you are satisfied from the evidence he has sustained as a direct result of the motor vehicle collision:

If you determine that Norman Conley is entitled to recover damages for his injuries, your award shall include compensation for losses attributable to or related to his pre-existing physical condition, but only if and to the extent that such pre-existing condition was aroused or aggravated by the accident in question.

1. Past Medical Expenses, not to exceed \$18,156.00 \$ 12,000.00

2. Past and Future Pain & Suffering, not to exceed \$500,000.00 \$ 110,000.00
