FINAL JUDGMENT

This cause came to be heard on September 25th & 26th, 2023, for a trial by jury upon the Complaint filed for Tatum M. Campbell. The Court summoned and empaneled a jury of fourteen (14) persons (including two alternates), and proceeded with the trial of this matter. The jury was duly sworn and consisted of the following individuals: Angela Harris, Jennifer House Hart, Russell Swindle, Don Davidson, Candice Boyd, Stacey Briggs, Clarence Thompson, Alice Olden, Joslyn Stewart, Shelley McClure, Jeff Phillips, and Dan Putrino. The parties conducted opening statements followed by presentation of evidence. Plaintiff, Tatum Campbell, called her witnesses and entered exhibits as evidence. Thereafter, Defendants, T.C. Restaurant Group and Chris Bullard, presented their evidence by calling witnesses and introducing exhibits.

After the parties closed their proof, the parties presented closing arguments, then the Court instructed the jury on the law applicable to this case and submitted a special verdict form for consideration by the jury. The jury then retired to deliberate.

After jury deliberations, the jury returned to the court room to render their verdict. The jury found that Defendant, Chris Bullard, was not negligent and therefore the Plaintiff could not recover a judgment against either Defendant based upon the finding that Defendant Bullard was not at fault. Therefore Plaintiff's claims against T.C. Restaurant Group, LLC d/b/a Luke's 32 Bridge Food + Drink and Chris Bullard are dismissed with prejudice.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that the Plaintiff, Tatum Campbell's Complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice and the Plaintiff shall take nothing from this civil action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs of this cause are taxed to Plaintiff, Tatum M. Campbell, and her surety for which execution may issue as necessary.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the issue of discretionary costs is reserved.


