JUDGMENT ENTRY AFTER JURY VERDICT

In the above case, trial by jury began August 8, 2023 and concluded on August 8, 2023. The Plaintiff, Curtis Herald, was present, in person for the jury trial and represented by attorneys, Troy Rivera. The Defendant, Lindsey Overstreet, was present, in person for the jury trial and represented by attorney Bette Peterson. On August 8, 2023, a jury was selected and the six-person jury with one alternate juror were impaneled and sworn.

The Plaintiff presented evidence on August 8, 2023. The Defendant presented evidence on August 8. The Court and attorneys settled final instructions of the Court. The parties agreed to the verdict form.

On August 8, 2023, the attorneys made their final arguments to the jury and the Court read the final instructions of the Court to the jury and provided the jury with copies of the written preliminary and final instructions #1 through #26. The jury retired for deliberation under a duly sworn bailiff.

The Court returned the jury into open Court, with the parties being present, and the jury returned its verdicts which reads as follows:

“We decide that the total amount of damages Curtis Herald is entitled to recover is \$10,000.

After the Court read the jury verdict, the Court thanked the jury and discharged them. The Court hereby enters judgment on behalf of the Plaintiff, Curtis Herald, to be awarded an amount of \$10,000.00.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that judgment be entered on the Plaintiffs' Complaint on behalf of the Plaintiff, Curtis Herald, in the amount of \$9,000.00. It is further Ordered that the Clerk shall place the original of this Order in the Record of Judgment and Orders. (RJO). Costs paid.
